Purpose:

- to enhance beginner's contest skills
- encourage use of CW (A1A) SSB (J3E) modes
- to assist in applying for "region qualifications" "NEW BUDAPEST AWARD" and for the title of "BUDAPEST VHF CHAMPION"
- to facilitate qualification points acquirement.

Date of contest:

First Monday (17.00-20.00 UTC) of each month from January to November (11 round)

Participant's :

Hungarian and foreign licencees who stays in Hungary and holds a valid radio amateur licence and all fireign licencee accepting the contest rules.

Preliminary contest registration:

According to the national contest rules (for Hungarian licencees only)

There is no preliminary registration is required for non-members of the Hungarian Radio Amateurs' Society, also foreign licencees or members not willing to take part in the national contesting qualification system. These entries will be qualified in open (invited) contest category.

CONTEST CLASSES:

- SO, MO (by band)
- SO-MB, MO-MB

- foreign radio amateurs :Multiband

- SWL

- open category

Frequency:

144 MHz - 10 GHz according to the IARU region 1 band plan except 145.500 MHz and repeater frequencies

Mode:

CW (A1A)

SSB (J3E)

FM (F3E)

Test call:

CW: CQ BP or TEST BP

SSB: CQ BUDAPEST

Report:

RST or RS + serial number starting with 001 (by band) and WW locator ( expl: 599 102 JN97NL )

Score:

Every valid QSO Km- distance = 1 point (144 MHz - 10 GHz), QSO in the same QTH area is 5 points.

Final score:

Amount of total QSO points from 144 MHz to 10 GHz times every valid QSO point amount:

All CW (A1A) points (total from 144 MHz to 10 GHz) times 3

ALL SSB (J3E) points (total from 144 MHz to 10 GHz) times 2

ALL FM (F3E) points (total from 144 MHz to 10 GHz) times 1

Invalid QSO:

incorrect callsign or incorrect serial number or points given for duplicate QSO

LOG FORM:

To be prepared on log 3-4 sheet or by computer: separate log monthly by each band. On the summary sheet all qsos have to be separately shown by band and the total score by band.

Logs have to be submitted within 15 days after the contest by mail or email to the following address:
